Donations and Tithing

Hello! My name is Abby McHenry, and I am the Director of Engagement and Donor Relations for the Sigma Alpha Omega Foundation. Something that has been on my mind since our fiscal year began in July is reframing how we view tithing and Stewardship.

Although we are not obligated to give, we are called to love God and love our neighbors as ourselves (Matthew 22:35-40). One way that people show this love is by giving funds to their church and other causes they support.

I used to think I had to give 10% of my income to the church I attended. That's it. Instead of that, I now think of tithing as giving back to the Body of Christ and the big "C" Church with whatever percentage is appropriate for you. What does that mean?

I currently give about 10% of my monthly income, but I divide it. I give about 40-50% of my monthly tithing to my actual home church, but the other 50-60% is allocated to alternative spaces. You do not need to do this, but I would encourage you to consider including SAOF or other smaller organizations that you care about in your monthly tithing. I budgeted everything and give accordingly.

Some people are unable to give financially, and that is completely understandable. We can only give what we are given. I know that sometimes it can be easy to be guilted into giving because we feel it's an obligation, but Jesus fulfilled the law and we are not required to do anything but love God and our neighbors.

However, if you are able to give, please consider partnering directly with SAOF by becoming a monthly contributor. One way to do this is by clicking on the PayPal link on our website and clicking the box that says "make this a monthly donation". The reason I ask this is so SAOF can provide more supports than we currently offer. We have the Emergency Relief Fund & Sisters Helping Sisters programs, but are also wanting to help sponsor a mission trip and continue offering grants throughout the year. I did the math. If every person in the Alumni Association on MySAO gave \$5 per month, SAOF would make \$7,200 per year on individual donors alone. Currently our operating budget is approximately \$4,000.


