New Year's Devotional EPHESIANS 4:22-24

"You were taught, with regard to your former way of life, to put off your old self, which is being corrupted by its deceitful desires; to be made new in the attitude of your minds; and to put on the new self, created to be like God in true righteousness and holiness."

A new year feels like a blank page, full of possibilities and hope. It's a time when many of us set resolutions, aiming to grow, improve, and embrace new habits. As young women, we're often pulled in many directions—juggling school, work, relationships, or personal goals. But amidst the busyness of life, Ephesians 4:22-24 offers a powerful reminder of the ultimate renewal: the transformation that comes from Christ.

Paul encourages us to "put off your old self." This means letting go of habits, attitudes, or patterns of thinking that don't align with God's purpose for us. It's not just about outward behavior but about inward change. The "old self" can include fear, envy, comparison, or striving for perfection. What parts of your old self might God be asking you to release as you step into this new year?

Next, we are called to "be made new in the attitude of your minds." Renewal begins with our thoughts. It's about choosing to focus on God's truth instead of the world's lies. This might mean spending more time in God's Word, seeking His guidance in prayer, or surrounding ourselves with uplifting community.

Finally, Paul urges us to "put on the new self." This is an invitation to embrace our identity in Christ—as beloved daughters of God, created in His image to reflect His righteousness and holiness. What a beautiful truth to carry into this year: you are being made new by the One who loves you most.

Action Steps for the New Year:

- 1. Reflect: Take some quiet time to journal or pray about the "old self" you need to let go of this year. What attitudes or habits is God asking you to release?
- Renew: Set a goal to spend time with God daily, whether through reading Scripture, prayer, or worship. Start small if needed—even five minutes can make a difference.
- 3. Reconnect: Find a faith community or accountability partner to encourage you in your walk with Christ. Sharing your journey with others can strengthen your faith.
- 4. Recommit: Write down one specific way you want to embrace your "new self" this year. Keep it somewhere visible as a reminder of God's work in your life.

Closing Thought:

As you step into this year, remember that true renewal doesn't come from your own efforts but from God's transformative power. Trust Him to guide you, strengthen you, and shape you into the woman He created you to be. Happy New Year!
